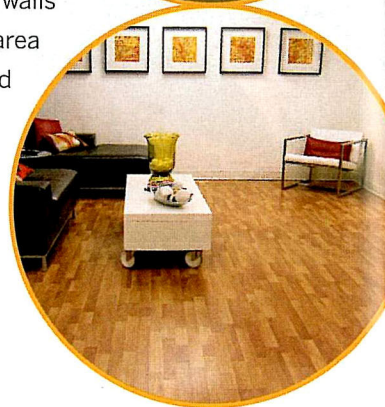


# HAIRCUTS & CANVASES

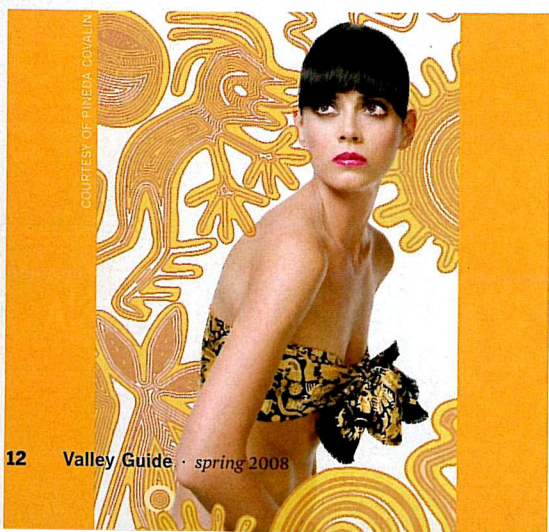
