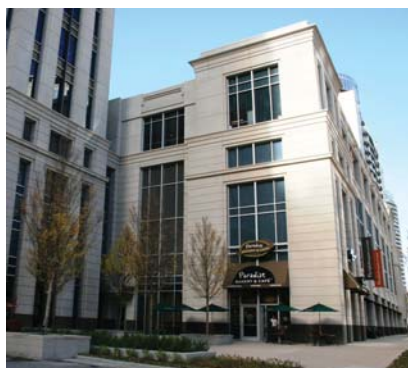
Love is just around the corner
